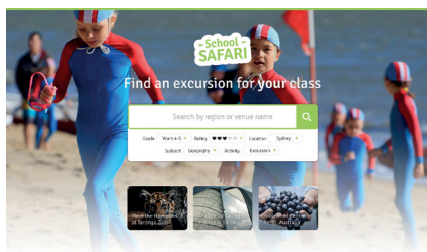


School Safari website aids excursion planning

A website designed to help schools to research and book excursions has been launched at www.schoolsafari.com.au. The process starts with a simple form that selects suitable field-trips by Region or Venue Name; Level, State; Subject and activity with drop down menus to refine searches.



A wide search for >Sydney found seven destinations, while >Science found 32 destinations and 40 programs. More selective searches narrowed the results: A search selecting >Sydney >Level 7-8 >Science >Excursion found The Botanic Gardens and Uneath Ed with one program offered by the former and a choice of five at Uneath Ed linked to an excursion booking form.

Natasha Keller, Community and Communications Manager said: “We are adding new destinations and excursions day by day and expect School Safari to become the first place to go when planning a local or interstate field trip.

“Many of the venues include a direct link to their bookings and enquiries page so schools can choose their destination and make a booking at the same time.”

New Snowflake version released

It is now also possible to make annotations on top of content in the Presenter app, which is ideal for teachers to make highlights on display.



The new upgrade is available for free download to licenced owners of MultiTeach as the software has a lifetime licence with free upgrades and no subscription fees.

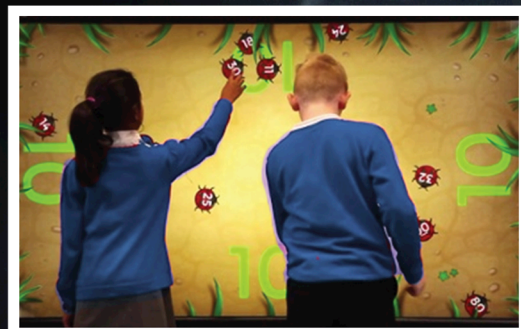
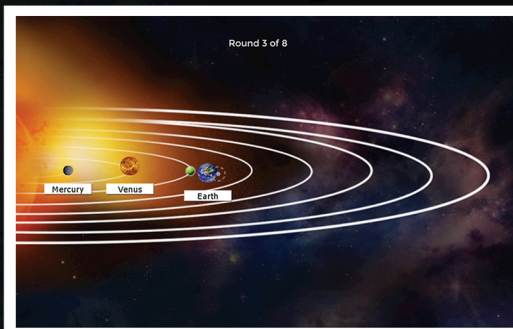
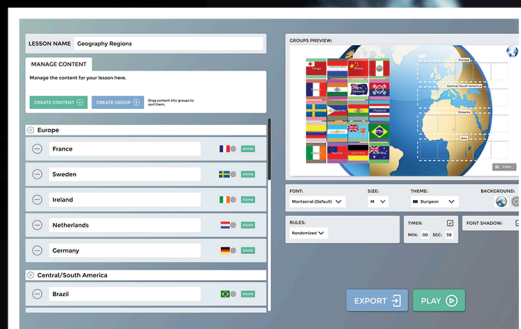

The exhibition will present products and services from 80 suppliers to the education sector.

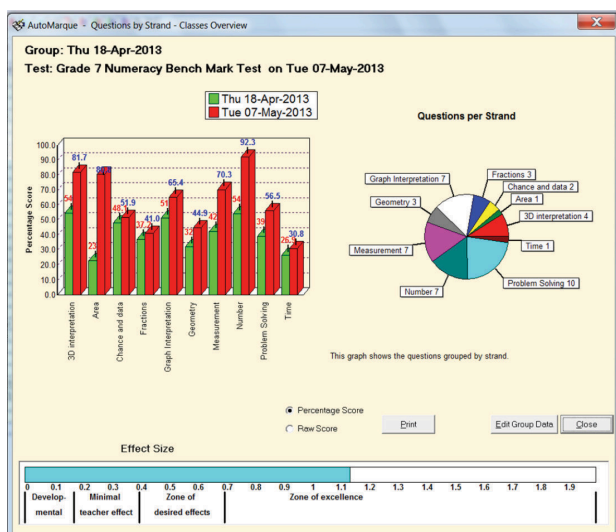
